




THE PIANO IS AN ABSTRACT SCULPTURE THAT COMBINES THE SIZE AND SHAPE OF A MEDIUM-SIZED GRAND PIANO WITH AN ASTROLAB.

IT HAS THREE SIMPLE, VERTICAL LEGS.
THE KEYBOARD IS A BLACK BOARD BRIDGING ACROSS TWO OF THE LEGS.
BRASS-LOOKING KEYS ARE STUCK TO IT.
THE PANO FRAME IS COMPOSED OF CURVED STRIPS OF MASO, LUAN, OR METAL.
BRASS-LOOKING ORBS ARE SUSPENDED IN THE MIDDLE OF THE PIANO.
THESE ARE PROBABLY HELD IN PLACE WITH BLACK DOWELS OR METAL RODS.
THESE SAME RODS MIGHT ADD STRUCTURAL INTEGRITY.
THE LEGS MIGHT BE FLANGED TO THE FLOOK.
